Who can apply?

- All applicants must be SASA registered and a member of a Midland District affiliated aquatics club, and
- All applicants must already be actively involved in the delivery of aquatics coaching within their club, whether a coach or pool side helper/coaching assistant for a minimum of 3 months, and
- All applications must be endorsed by their Club President.

How much is the Grant worth?

- Midland District support towards a UKCC level 1 would be £50.00
- Support towards a UKCC Level 2 or above would be £50.00; further assistance would be at the discretion of the District Executive.
- Grants are available subject to availability of District funds. Access to grants can be withdrawn by the District Executive without notice.
